BIRTH: She was born Sarah Ann Peel in Durham in 1874 and was baptised in Birkenshaw on 29 March 1875 at the Birkenshaw Wesleyan-Methodist Chapel when she was 10 months old. The address given for the baptismal records was Tottenham, Durham.

PARENTS: Her father was Benjamin Peel, colliery deputy and Sophia Peel, nee Elstob. They were married on 12 February 1872 at Heworth, Durham.

MARRIAGE: Sarah Ann married Charles Newsome, boot and shoemaker of Kirkburton, at the Parish Church of St Thomas at Purston cum South Featherstone, Yorkshire on 03 November 1894.

Charles's father was Robert Newsome, a farmer.

CHILDREN: Sarah Ann and Charles had four children – Arthur born on 18 April 1895, Robert Peel born in April 1896, Agnes born on 08 October 1898 and Cyril born in 1905.

DEATH: Sarah died on 04 October 1945 and her address at the time of her death was 17 Turnshaw Road, Kirkburton. Probate was granted to her husband.

OTHER INFORMATION: Sarah's son Robert served and survived but her son Robert was killed in July 1918. Both names are listed on the Memorial Board.
