BIRTH: Agnes was born on 12 April 1882 and was baptised on 23 May 1883 at All Hallows Parish Church, Kirkburton.

PARENTS: Her father was Joe Scott, a stone mason and her mother was Jane Scott, nee Armitage. Agnes's parents were married on 11 February 1869 at All Hallows Parish Church, Kirkburton.

Joe's father was John Hampshire Scott, farmer. Jane's father was George Armitage, farmer.

Joe and Jane had four children – George Victor born in October 1879, Agnes born in 1882, Albert born on 09 February 1888, and Alice born on 18 January 1890.

DEATH: Agnes Scott died in March 1967 aged 84.

OTHER INFORMATION: Agnes was a weaver in the 1911 census and she was living with her mother, brothers and sister in Highburton. George Victor was a weaver, Albert was a joiner and Alice was a dressmaker.

Their father, Joe, died in January 1894 and he was buried at All Hallows Parish Church, Kirkburton on 10 January 1894.

Agnes's brother Albert served during the Great War and survived - his name is listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
