PARENTS: Ellen's father was Thomas Senior, a butcher and her mother was Ada Senior, nee Armitage. Thomas and Ada married at St Paul's Church, Shepley on 29 October 1883

Thomas and Ada had three children – Ellen Elizabeth, Thomas Harold and Victor Allen.

MARRIAGE: Ellen married Paul Theodore Sugden, a bank clerk on 30 September 1913 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton.

OTHER INFORMATION: Paul enlisted with the RASC on 28 March 1915, was promoted to Sergeant and 23 August 1917 and was discharged from service on 15 June 1919.
