### **Additional Information:**

**BIRTH:** Annie was born Annie Elizabeth Haigh on 21 April 1878 and was baptised on 21 April 1878 at All Hallows Parish Church, Kirkburton.

**PARENTS:** Her father was Henry Haigh, a weaver, and her mother was Harriet Haigh, nee Kaye. They were married at St Paul's Church, Huddersfield on 09 June 1877.

Henry's father John Haigh was deceased at the time of their marriage and Harriet's father was Charles Kaye, a weaver.

**MARRIAGE:** Annie, a mill hand, married Wilfred Sykes, a worsted healdler, on 20 January 1906 at Salem Chapel Berry Brow. Wilfred's father was Israel Sykes, pattern weaver. Both were living in Almondbury at the time of their marriage.

**CHILDREN:** Annie and Henry had a son, Ronald born on 12 December 1906 and baptised at Newsome Methodist Chapel on 07 April 1907. The family was living at Far Dene, Kirkburton at the time of the baptism.
