**BIRTH:** Eleanor was born Eleanor Shaw in 1880 and she was baptised on 26 May 1880.

**PARENTS:** Her father was David Stott Shaw, a gas works manager, born in Lindley and her mother was Mary Shaw, nee Bamforth.

David and Mary had eight children – James born on 08 November 1863, John William born on 17 October 1866 , Harriet Ann born on 12 January 1870, Louisa born on 18 January 1872, Lewis born on 22 March 1874, Arthur born on 15 April 1876 , David Henry baptised on 19 June 1878 and Eleanor baptised on 26 May 1880.

**MARRIAGE:** Eleanor married Joseph Washington, a piano tuner born in Shepley, at Thurstonland Parish Church on 20 December 1903. Joseph's mother was Mary Jane Washington and no father's name for Joseph is recorded on the marriage certificate.

**CHILDREN:** Eleanor and Joseph had one son – Karl Millard Washington who was born.

**DEATH:** Eleanor died in 07 January 1959 and probate was granted to her son Karl Millard Washington, a sales manager. At the time of her death Eleanor was living at 67 Huddersfield Road, Skelmanthorpe.

**OTHER INFORMATION:** In the 1891 census Eleanor, her parents and brothers and sisters were living at Lee Lane, Kirkburton

At the time of Eleanor and Joseph's marriage, Eleanor was working as an assistant mistress and was living in Shelley.

In the 1911 census, Eleanor and Joseph were living at 6 Union Street, Penistone with their son and Eleanor's father.
