BIRTH: Maria was born Anna Maria Whittell in April 1854.

PARENTS: Maria's parents were Joseph Whittell and Ann Whittle, nee Fishburn. Joseph and Ann were married in Kirkheaton on 30 April 1837.

Joseph and Ann had six children – Emma born on 23 June 1838, Henry Augustine born in 1844, Frederick born 21 February 1849, Joe Knight born in 1852, Anna Maria born in April 1854 and Franklin Shaw born 06 Jun 1856.

DEATH: Maria died on 09 September 1939 and probate was granted to Joseph Franklin Whittell. Joseph Franklin was Maria's nephew, son of her brother Franklin Shaw Whittell.

Maria was living at Dene Cliffe, Kirkburton at the time of her death.

OTHER INFORMATION: The 1911 census shows her as a visitor at West End Villas, Horbury living on her own means. The head of the house was Eliza Mellor, widow living on her own means, with Marion Mellor, who was Eliza's daughter, and a servant.

In 1910 Maria is listed with a Tax Valuation for 1-5 Spring Bank Cottages, Kirkburton which was a house and shop. The property was owned by Emmeline Berg.

Maria is listed on the Kirkburton Electoral Rolls at Spring Bank from 1893 to 1915.
