### **Additional Information:**

**BIRTH:** Florence Isabella was born in October 1894 and was baptised on 14 April 1895 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton

**PARENTS:** Her father was Albert Franklin Carter, an edge tool maker from Highburton, and her mother was Sarah Ann Carter, nee Goldthorpe from Kirkburton. They were married on 01 June 1885 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton. Albert's father was Jere Carter, an edge tool maker, and Sarah's father was David Goldthorpe, a weaver.

Albert and Sarah had four children – Sarah Elizabeth born 1897, Arthur William born 1899, Edward Percy born 1893 and Florence Isabella born 1894

Florence Isabella's mother, Sarah, died aged 38 years and was buried at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton on 12 December 1896.

**MARRIAGE:** Florence Isabella married James Rhodes , a woollen merchant, at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton on 31 December 1928. James's father was Albert Rhodes, a farmer of Low Fold Farm, Kirkburton

**OTHER INFORMATION:** The 1911 census shows Florence Isabella as a sixteen year old student living with her father and siblings, however the address on the census only states that the family lived in Kirkburton. The census shows Albert to be a widower.

Florence Isabella's brother, James William Carter served during the Great War and is named on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
