**BIRTH:** Sarah Elizabeth was born on 28 January 1887 and was baptized on 06 April 1887.

**PARENTS:** Sarah was the daughter of Albert Franklin Carter, edge tool maker and Sarah Ann Carter, nee Goldthorpe who were married on 01 June 1885.

Albert's father was Jere Carter, edge tool maker of Highburton and Sarah's father was David Goldthorpe of Kirkburton, a weaver.

Albert and Sarah had four other children – Arthur William born on 18 August 1888, Edward Percy born on 29 May 1892, Florence Isabella baptised on 14 April 1895 and Mary Hannah who was born on 08 April 1890 but died on 12 August 1892 aged 2 years

**MARRIAGE:** Sarah married David Edwards, a market gardener of Highburton, on 31 December 1928 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton when she was 41 and he was 42. David's father was William Edwards, a tin plate worker.
