**BIRTH:** Selina was born on 04 November 1868.

**PARENTS:** Selina's parents were George and Emma Jackson, farmers, who were married at St Michael and All Angels Church, Thornhill. Selina's mother was born Emma Earnshaw of Netherton, Wakefield and Emma's father was Benjamin Earnshaw, woodman.

**MARRIAGE:** Wilfred Carter, spade manufacturer, married Selina Jackson on 05 August 1859 at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton. Wilfred's father was Richard Carter, spade and shovel maker.

**CHILDREN:** Selina was the mother of John Wilfred Carter, Frederick Albert Carter and Frank Gordon Carter.

**DEATH:** Selina died on 12 September 1949 at St Mary's Hospital, Deanhouse, Netherthong.

**OTHER INFORMATION:** All three of Selina's sons served during the Great War. John Wilfred Carter served and died but Frederick Albert Carter and Frank Gordon Carter both served and returned. All three sons are listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
