BIRTH: Jane was born Jane Frances Jessie Withers Moore in 1874.

PARENTS: Her father was Henry Dawson Moore, clerk in holy orders, and her mother was Harriet Louisa Moor. In 1901 Robert was listed as a poultry farmer living at Scopwick Lodge, Sleaford and the couple had servants.

MARRIAGE: Jane married Robert Clark, farmer on 03 February 1898 at St Mary's, Balham, Streatham, London. Robert's father was William Bentley Clark deceased farmer of Bedale. Jane's father was Henry Dawson Moore was deceased at the time of their marriage.

CHILDREN: Mary Frances Withers Clark born January 1906 at Patrick Brompton, Bedale, North Yorkshire.

DEATH: 02 April 1933 at Scruton, near Bedale, North Yorkshire.

OTHER INFORMATION: In the 1891 census her father was the vicar of Hornby, Yorkshire and she was living with her parents at the vicarage. Jane was 23 at that time and her occupation was listed a trained nurse.

On the 1911 census, Jane and Robert were living at Patrick Brompton, Bedale, they had a 5 year old daughter Mary Frances Withers Clark and a servant - Robert was 56 and Jane 37. Robert's occupation was a farmer. Jane and Robert are on 1918 electoral roll in Kirkburton but it is not clear what they were doing in the village.
