**BIRTH:** Born Alma Copley on 25 March 1857 and was baptised on 10 June 1857 in Kirkburton

**PARENTS:** Her father was Ben Copley weaver and her mother was Mary Copley nee Newton. Her parents were married at All Hallows Church Kirkburton on 07 November 1853.

**MARRIAGE:** On 18 November 1876 Alma married Joseph Lee Cockhill, Engine Tenter for West Riding County Council at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton. Joseph's parents were James and Martha Cockhill of Kirkburton.

**CHILDREN:** Alma and Lee had two children. Their daughter, Clara, was born on 14 March 1878 and their son, Jim, was born on 11 January 1881. They were both baptised at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton on 08 November 1885.

**DEATH:** Alma was living at Ellis Square, Kirkburton when she died in September 1837, she was buried at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton on 08 September 1837

**OTHER INFORMATION:** Alma had two sisters. Emma was born in 1854 and Emily was born in 1859.
