BIRTH: She was born Mary Hannah Wood on 22 May 1876 and was baptized at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton on 02 March 1890 with her three brothers.

PARENTS: Mary's father was Alfred Wood, weaver and their mother was Martha Ellen Wood. They had four children – Mary Hannah born 1876, James Wright born 13 September 1878, Herbert Gladstone born 20 June 1883 and George Alfred born 22 August 1886

MARRIAGE: Mary married John Webster Eastwood who was born at Farnley Tyas on 08 November 1893 at All Hallows, Kirkburton. John's father was Joseph Eastwood, farmer and Mary's father was a weaver on the marriage documents.

CHILDREN: Mary and John had five children – Clarence born January 1894 , Fred born 09 April 1895, Dyson born April 1897, Phyllis born 02 October 1899 and John born 30 May 1906.

DEATH: Mary died on 29 September 1942.

OTHER INFORMATION: In the 1911 census, Mary's husband was a publican and she was assisting him in the business.

Mary's sons, Clarence and Dyson, both served during the Great War and their names are listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
