**BIRTH:** Harriet was born Harriet Theresa Geissler in 1895 and baptised at Kirkburton All Hallows on 12 April 1895.

**PARENTS:** Agnes's parents were Agnes Geissler, nee Shaw, and Arthur Geissler, who was a dyer in the 1911 census but subsequently became an auctioneer and land valuer.

Agnes' parents were Jabez Shaw and Alice Shaw, nee Goldthorpe who were married at All Hallows Church, Kirkburton on 17 July 1843.

Agnes and Arthur were married in January 1893 and had two children – Harriet Theresa born 1895 and Herman Gustav born 1897. Gustav only lived for one month after his birth.
