BIRTH: Ruth Hannah was born on 08 December 1864 and was baptised on 25 March 1865

PARENTS: Her mother was Elizabeth Overend, nee Robson and her father was Samuel Overend, architect.

MARRIAGE: Ruth married Frederick Jackson, elementary school master, in July 1866 in Dewsbury.

CHILDREN: Ruth and Frederick had three children – Elsie born 1888, Marguerite born 1889 and Oswald Overend Jackson born 1897.

DEATH: Ruth died on 21 January 1948 in Malton and her estate was left to her daughter Elsie.

OTHER INFORMATION: Ruth's daughter Elsie Jackson also worked at the Kirkburton Hospital.

Ruth was the mother of Oswald Overend Jackson who served during the Great War and his name is listed on the Memorial Board in Kirkburton Library.
