PARENTS: Jane's father was Thomas Scott and her mother was Elizabeth Ann Scott, nee Bell.

MARRIAGE: Jane married Harry Booth, a grocer of Forrester Row, Kirkburton on 29 April 1907 at Honley Parish Church. At the time of her marriage, Jane was a telephone operator from Honley.

Jane's father, Thomas Scott, was deceased at the time of their marriage and had been a shopkeeper. Harry's father was also deceased at the time of the marriage and had been a woollen spinner.

CHILDREN: Jane and Harry had one child, Ida, who was born on 05 September 1910 and died in November 1910 when she was a month old.
